SITE PREP BEGINS FOR UW-MILWAUKEE SCHOOL OF PUBLIC HEALTH



MILWAUKEE – Preparation work recently began at the future site of the UW-Milwaukee School of Public Health. The School will occupy a 33,000-square-foot building located in the former Pabst Brewery complex. A 23,000-square-foot addition will also be added to the building.

With construction set to begin in May 2011, the facility will house classrooms, epidemiology & biostatistic labs, community health promotion, environmental health and an outreach office of the Milwaukee Health Department.

The School of Public Health was established by UW-Milwaukee in 2008 and is committed to establishing itself as a premier urban research institution. The new location will allow the School to support collaboration and interdisciplinary research, gain greater access to clinical populations and better position UW-Milwaukee for research funding.
