## MILWAUKEE INTERMODAL STATION AND MANPOWER WORLD HEADQUARTERS NAMED TOP PROJECTS OF 2007

MILWAUKEE — *The Daily Reporter* and *Wisconsin Builder* have recognized the Milwaukee Intermodal Station and Manpower World Headquarters as two of the “Top Projects of 2007.” The annual Top Projects awards recognize projects that faced significant challenges, used new materials and techniques, or made important contributions to the community they serve.

Eppstein Uhen Architects was challenged to overcome several obstacles in designing both of the award-winning projects. The Milwaukee Intermodal Station project initially experienced a lack of funding until City officials including Mayor Tom Barrett, Planning Director Bob Greenstreet and Alderman Bob Bauman successfully championed for a more fitting budget that allowed for the new design to be implemented. The renovated transit facility now features striking design elements such as crisscrossing white beams and a glass curtain wall, providing an exciting gateway to the City of Milwaukee.

The Manpower World Headquarters project also brought along its own set of challenges. Manpower’s new 2.74-acre site was a former brownfield with significant contaminants from prior uses. The project team successfully converted the site into an environmentally-sound area and the 280,000-square-foot headquarters is now slated to achieve Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Gold Certification.
